In the Spotlight...

Polio Update — END POLIO NOW!

Launched in 1985, Rotary International’s PolioPlus world-wide initiative offered an initial pledge of \$120 million and thousands of helping hands to assist in the distribution of the oral live vaccine to children.

The Western hemisphere is declared polio-FREE in 1994.

1995: Rotarians and other volunteers immunize 165 million children in China and India.

1996: # of countries declared polio-FREE rises to 150.

1997: 134 million children of India immunized on ONE day.

2000: 550 million children immunized. The Western Pacific region, Australia to China, declared polio-FREE.

2003: ONLY 7 COUNTRIES are polio-endemic

PolioPlus Partners program initiated, bringing in donors such as the Bill Gates Foundation.

2007: ONLY 4 COUNTRIES remain polio-endemic:
Afghanistan, India, Nigeria, Pakistan
